So thankful that even though we registered so many cases of malaria and flu, our kids survived and they are all back safe!! The spiritual transformation also continues to take place. Their worship to God and singing praises to Him has thrilled us to this day. Great is His faithfulness.

We continue to lose good teachers due to poor pay after training them and sharing the greater vision and call with them. We are however, thankful that we are able to find replacement teachers, though it slightly drags us behind, but eventually they catch up.

- That our great God will make a way, even where there seems to be no way, and we are able to pay better wages so that we're able to keep our staff.
- Currently, we are experiencing a terrible drought that is greatly affecting us. This also comes with diseases, has affected the price of food and obtaining scholastic materials. Please pray that we are able to navigate these challenges by God's grace!
- The number of students is much higher compared to the means we have! It's been a challenge to maintain operations on our small budget for the school. Due to this, it occasionally requires us to acquire loans to keep going. We covet your prayers and request you to prayerfully consider supporting us even more.

It's always a miracle that we start the term and end it while joyfully serving. Surely we have experienced God's divine providence.

We are so thankful for the water supply to the school. We forever thank you Soul Care for all this. May God mightily bless you! We can't imagine how we could operate without your support. May God richly bless you all.
